



Smile Design

Challenging cosmetic makeovers are a reality encountered in the everyday dental practice, yet many dentists are too intimidated to consider their undertaking. The goal of this hands-on workshop is to introduce the general dentist to the proper methods that must be employed during examination, diagnosis, and treatment planning of such complex cases. The principles of smile design will be illustrated, and a detailed outline of proper tooth preparation for all-ceramic restorations will be presented. The participant will then apply these principles by preparing an aesthetic porcelain laminate veneer case on a typodont and by practicing bonding of a porcelain laminate veneer to the typodont. In this manner, participants will leave this hands-on workshop with the confidence to begin expanding their practice by performing previously unfeasible cosmetic cases.

Hands-on Portion

- Participants will prepare 6 anterior typodont teeth for porcelain laminate veneers.
- Participants will practice fabricating provisional restorations for veneers using a putty stent.

- How to use smile design principles in shaping teeth.
- Ideal tooth preparations for all porcelain restorations and the Zeneer™.
- Techniques for simplifying tooth preparation (prep teeth with mock-up in place).
- Procedure for fabricating exceptional provisionals.
- How to use provisional to evaluate esthetics, phonetics, and function.
